- · Monday to Friday with own transport required

- Physical ability to be able to perform the required manual handling duties of a carer
- Evidence of current flu and COVID vaccinations maybe required for mandatory work placement requirements
- · National Police Check
- Working with Children (Blue Card)
- NDIS Worker's Screening Card (Yellow Card)
- · Language, literacy and numeracy assessment
