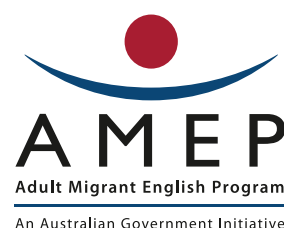




# STEPS



## READY FOR WORK COURSE

Are you looking for work? Adult Migrant English Program (AMEP) students may be eligible to take part in the Ready for Work short course.

### This short course will help you learn:

- How to write a resume and job application
- How to find work
- How to prepare for a job interview

- Workplace health and safety rules

- Can commit to a full time course
