Delivery and duration

- Self-directed study

Work placement

- 120 hours of work placement is required to achieve this qualification within the Ageing and Disability sector including evidence of hours worked
- Monday to Friday with own transport required

Entry requirements

- Physical ability to be able to perform the required manual handling duties of a carer
- Evidence of current flu and COVID vaccinations maybe required for mandatory work placement requirements
- National Police Check
- Working with Children (Blue Card)
- NDIS Worker's Screening Card (Yellow Card)
- Language, literacy and numeracy assessment
