- · Permanently reside in Queensland
- Be employed in aged, disability or community care industries in a care support role
- Have sound literacy, numeracy and computer skills
- Be aged 15 years or over
- · No longer be attending school
- Be an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident (includes humanitarian entrant), temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permit on the pathway to permanent residency, or a New Zealand citizen; and not hold or be enrolled in a Certificate IV or higher-level qualification, this does not include qualifications completed at school and foundation skills training
